Lincoln, NE, June 11, 2020 – As a unified voice for public education in Nebraska, the leaders, members and employees of the Nebraska Association of School Boards (NASB), Nebraska Council of School Administrators (NCSA), and the Nebraska State Education Association (NSEA) join Commissioner Matt Blomstedt, as Nebraska and the entire country work to end systemic racism through education policies and practices.
