

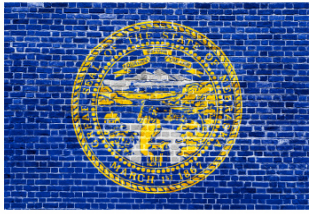

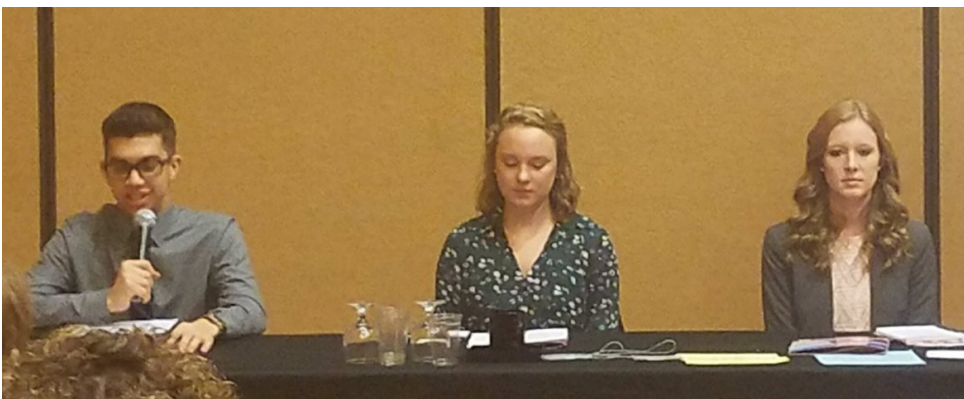

AT THE ANNUAL NASB DELEGATE ASSEMBLY, OUTGOING PRESIDENT, LINDA RICHARDS OF RALSTON PASSED THE CEREMONIAL GAVEL TO LANNY BOSWELL OF LINCOLN PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

BOSWELL HAS SERVED ON THE LPS BOARD SINCE 2013, AND BEEN A MEMBER OF THE NASB BOARD OF DIRECTORS SINCE 2013 AS WELL.

IN ADDITION TO BOSWELL TAKING OVER AS PRESIDENT, STACIE HIGGINS OF NEBRASKA CITY WAS ELECTED TO SERVE AS NASB'S VICE PRESIDENT, TO BEGIN HER FOUR-YEAR RUN AS AN OFFICER. SHE HAS BEEN A MEMBER OF THE NEBRASKA CITY BOARD SINCE 2008.

JON ANDERJASKA OF WAUNETA-PALISADE, WHO SERVED AS NASB'S PRESIDENT IN 2016 WAS HONORED FOR HIS SERVICE TO THE NASB BOARD OF DIRECTORS AS BOTH A REGION DIRECTOR FOR EIGHT YEARS, AND AN OFFICER FOR THE LAST FOUR. WHILE ANDERJASKA'S RUN AS AN NASB OFFICER HAS CONCLUDED, HE WILL REMAIN ON HIS LOCAL BOARD WHERE HE HAS SERVED SINCE 1997.

STEVE BLOCHER OF WEST POINT WILL BEGIN HIS SECOND YEAR AS AN OFFICER, MOVING FROM VICE PRESIDENT, TO PRESIDENT-ELECT, AND WILL SERVE AS PRESIDENT IN 2019. HIGGINS, WILL SERVE AS PRESIDENT IN 2020.

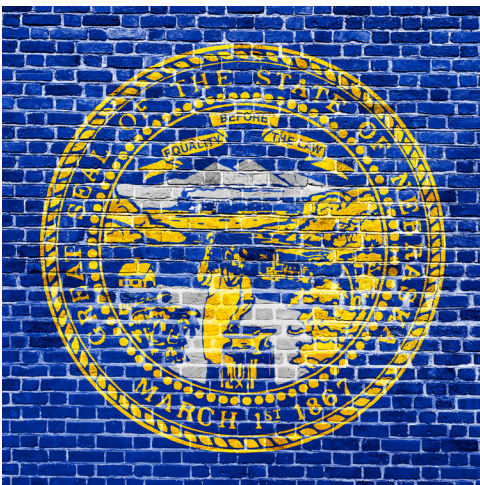
