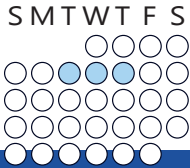

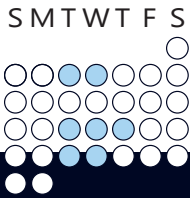

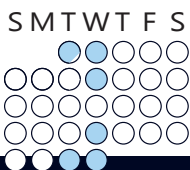

# LB 596 - CHANGES TO THE OPEN MEETINGS ACT

*LB 596 - Change requirements for legal publications and notices required by law, provisions of the Open Meetings Act, county inventories, warrants, and discharge records, storage requirements for certain records, petitions to change names, marriage license and record fees, reports of abandoned property, and the Nebraska Hall of Fame and eliminate a penalty for certain public officials and provisions relating to the registration of farm, ranch, or home names - Approved by Governor on April 14, 2026*

## LB 596 ... IN A NUTSHELL

- Designate how you provide notice
- Every meeting must have in its minutes how notice was provided.
- Don't have to put it in the newspaper (but you can)
- Publish the time and location of monthly meetings ... 4x per year

## KEY CHANGES ...

- Schools are no longer mandated to publish notice of each meeting in a local newspaper.
  - Requirement is reasonable advanced publicized notice.
- A method of notice must be designated by the school and meeting minutes must record how notice was provided.
- Schools need to publish notice 4 times a year the regular meeting schedule, the location and the method designated by the public body to provide reasonable advanced publicized notice.

## NOTICE OF MEETING PROVISIONS ...

- Schools need to give "reasonable advance publicized notice of the time and place of each meeting by a method designed by each public body and recorded in its minutes."
  - Schools need to make sure their policy states how they are going to provide notice for meetings and after each meeting, there needs to be a mention in the minutes on how notice was provided.
  - Meeting notice is now what it was prior to 2020, which is reasonable advance publicized noticed. LB 596 **removes** the requirement for each meeting notice to be published in the newspaper.
- New – "notice shall be given at least four times each year of the regular meeting schedule, the location, and the method designated by the public body to provide reasonable advance publicized notice. Such notice shall be given by publication in a legal newspaper of general circulation within the public body's jurisdiction."
  - This is new language and a new requirement. This provision must be followed four times a year. The law takes effect in July of 2026, so your school will need to publish four notices before December 31, 2026. In calendar year 2027, you will need to show evidence of this publication four times. There is no statutory requirement on when during the year you need to publish.
- The requirement that the OMA needs to be posted in the room is eliminated. You still need to have the OMA available, but you no longer need a poster on the wall.

## CONCLUSION ...

- You need to designate how you are going to provide "reasonable advance publicized notice" for all regular and special board meetings.
  - You can post around town, post on your website, publish in a newspaper, email notice to citizens through Sparq Meetings, or any combination of these options as long as it is reasonable and in advance.
  - If you are currently publishing in a newspaper, you may continue to do so, however it is not mandatory. Be sure to follow your policy on how notice is provided.
  - Four times a year you need to publish the location and schedule of your regularly scheduled meetings with information on how you will provide notice for each meeting.

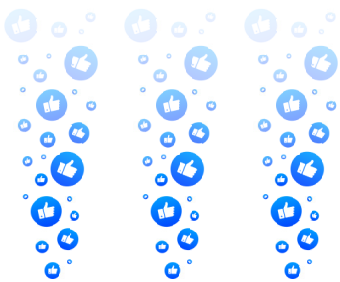
