POLICY SERVICES ... Policy serves as the foundation for effective governance, but strong systems require more than adoption alone. The updated service offers a manual authored by Perry Law Firm, integration into SPARQ Online Publishing, and so much more.

QUORUMS ... Periodically, questions arise when a quorum of a school board attends an NASB workshop, convention, or other educational event. **Is that allowed under the Nebraska Open Meetings Act?** Yes. Nebraska Statute § 84-1410 specifically exempts travel to and attendance at workshops, conferences, and similar events from the definition of a meeting, even when a quorum of the board is present. The important limitation is that board members should not use the occasion to discuss or take action on business that is specifically related to their own school district. Attend, learn, network, and enjoy the opportunity - but save your district's business for a properly noticed board meeting!

TECHNOLOGY ... Negotiations season is here! If you are a new superintendent or someone who needs a refresher, please don't hesitate to reach out to Darion to schedule a training. Shari Becker, Director of the Education Leadership Search Service and Past Chair of NASS, maintains direct relationships with 39 state school board associations. This network expands our national reach and strengthens our ability to identify candidates and conduct thorough reference checks. In addition, applications are submitted through an online platform shared with 14 other states, providing national visibility for each search.

NASB staff carefully screen every applicant using a detailed protocol, ensuring the board receives a clear picture of each candidate's experience, qualifications, and leadership qualities. Candidate information is presented to the board in both open and closed sessions as appropriate.

Our commitment doesn't end when your new leader is hired. Being a member district allows you access to any of our staff members specializing in various areas to provide support to the board or your new leader as you continue to navigate the new relationship and build trust. NASB can also provide a transition retreat, transition materials, and a board retreat once the new leader is in place.

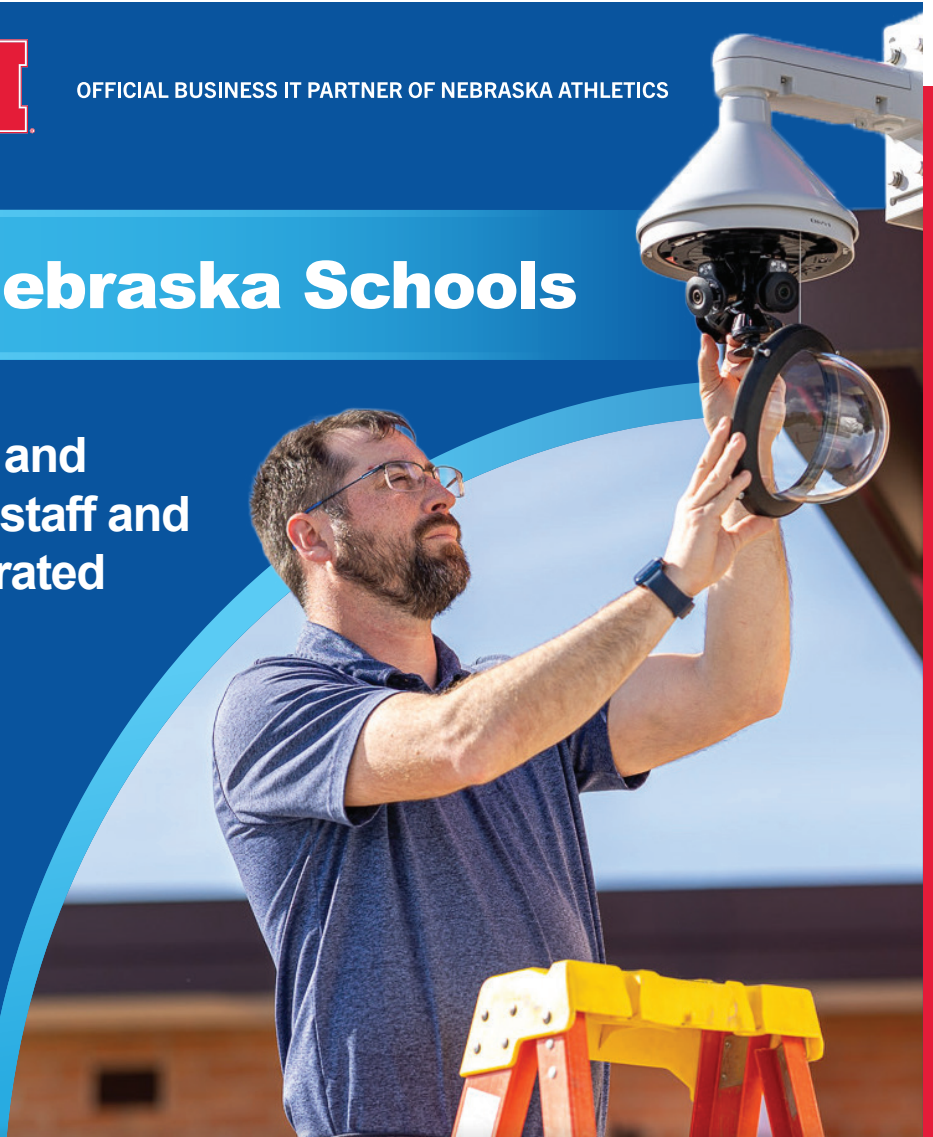

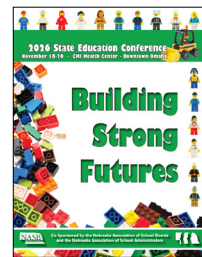

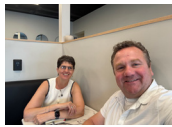
