Why is DHS phasing out the DACA Program?
 Citing the result of recent litigation, DHS decided to wind the program down instead of forcing the judiciary to shut the program down completely and immediately. On Sept. 4, 2017 Attorney General Sessions sent a letter to Acting Homeland Security Secretary Duke informing DHS that DACA "was effected by the previous administration through executive action, without proper statutory authority and with no established end-date that Congress' repeated rejection of proposed legislation that would have accomplished a similar result. Such an open-ended circumvention of immigration laws was an unconstitutional exercise of authority by the Executive Branch."
