Annual Member Golf Outing | June 14 | Kearney Country Club

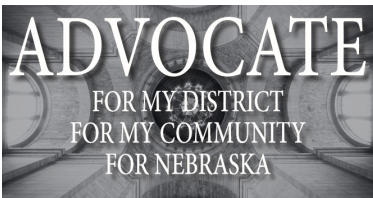
